2009 – 2010 CLASSROOM CONNECT MATCH SMARTBOARD Q & A

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE Classroom Connect Match SMARTBOARD FUND?

The purpose is to provide a fund that will assist schools in stimulating new contributors and support for school improvement in the form of a SMARTBOARD.

WHO MAY APPLY?

Principals may extend this invitation to any teacher at their school.

MAY ONE SCHOOL APPLY MORE THAN ONCE?

Yes, a school may submit more than one application. There is a limit of 5 awards per school.

MAY THE FUNDS COME FROM MULTIPLE SOURCES?

Yes, funds may come from either one source or multiple sources but must be from private sources, not government funding. PTA's, Civic organizations, businesses and parents are acceptable.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR HAVING SCHOOL FUNDS MATCHED?

The school just fills out the Classroom Connect Match SMARTBOARD application and sends to MIS Department, Attn: John Just, Administration Building. You must indicate the source of the \$2000. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Once your application has been approved, the Pinellas Education Foundation will contact you via email.

OUR SCHOOL HAS BEEN CONTACTED BY THE FOUNDATION THAT OUR PROJECT HAS BEEN APPROVED. WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

The school must send in their \$2000 check(s) to the Foundation. The check(s) must be made out to the Pinellas Education Foundation and mailed or delivered to 12090 Starkey Road, Largo, FL 33773. Please indicate on the memo line "SMARTBOARD". Once the funds have been received the Foundation will notify the school and the MIS Department. At this time the classroom teacher receiving the SMARTBOARD must complete the online professional development training. Once training is completed the district will coordinate installation.

IS THERE A DEADLINE FOR APPLYING?

There are 50 SMARTBOARDS available with a limit of 5 per school. Apply early.

HOW SOON AFTER BEING APPROVED DO I NEED TO HAVE THE \$2000 SUBMITTED TO THE FOUNDATION?

Your school has 3 weeks to provide the \$2000 to the Foundation once you receive your email confirmation approval. Failure to do so will result in termination of the award. If termination occurs all funds will be returned to the school.

HOW SOON AFTER BEING APPROVED DO I NEED TO HAVE MY (TEACHER) ONLINE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT TRAINING?

The sooner the better. The order will not be processed for the SMARTBOARD for that teacher until the training is complete.

IF I ALREADY HAD THIS TRAINING DO I NEED TO TAKE IT AGAIN?

If you have completed the online training in Moodle for SMARTBOARDS, you will not be required to take further training. Any other training from Smart, vendors, conferences, or train-the-trainer session in Pinellas cannot substitute for the Moodle training.
