Individual In-School/Virtual Mentor

All mentors will register as volunteers for Pinellas County Schools and attend a training workshop. [PCS Registration LINK](#)

- 30-minutes a week, twice a month, to meet with a student in school or virtually
- Encourage scholars to graduate from high school while maintaining good grades and remaining drug and crime free

Guest Presenter for Group Mentoring

Group leaders can present a topic, have a discussion or lead an engaging activity -- anything appropriate and relevant to a middle or high school student including careers, hobbies, life skills, or academics

- One 30-minute session, no long-term commitment
- No need to register as a mentor or Pinellas County School volunteer
