



**Jabil STEM classroom grant opportunity!** Once again, we are able to offer \$1000 grants, which must focus on a STEM in-action project. To be eligible to apply, you must be at a Title 1 school.

Remember to be considered for funding you must focus on the following areas:

1. Computer Systems
  - a. Coding and Web Development
  - b. Software and Application Creation
  - c. Computer Analytics
2. Electricity/Circuits
3. Engineering
  - a. Design and CAD (computer-aided design)
  - b. Electrical
  - c. "Green" and Energy Efficient
  - d. Mechanical
4. Mathematics
  - a. Statistics
  - b. Data Analytics
  - c. Algebra, Geometry, Calculus
5. Robotics

**Examples of acceptable uses of funding:**

1. Purchase water-resistant materials to make model homes to address flooding challenges
2. Programmable robots to learn basic coding
3. Purchase of 3D printer for mathematics and technology studies
4. Supplies for robotics and drone clubs
5. Materials that support engineering projects/building workable machines, circuits and robots
6. Materials needed to build a mobile STEM lab
7. Purchase of specialty textbooks necessary to teach STEM-related subjects like those listed above
8. Field trip with a specific, well-defined STEM-connection and includes a hands-on learning component
9. Graphing and mathematics supplies, such as protractors, compasses and calculators

**Examples of unacceptable uses of funding (from previous years):**

1. Textbooks or manipulatives that don't support Jabil's STEM-concentrations
2. Buying materials and equipment with no explanation how it will be used or STEM activity supported
3. Field trips that have no direct STEM connection or hands-on activity
4. Agricultural studies and activities



Remember your \$1000 grant needs to

- Use funds for materials and equipment for hands-on projects or activities, as well as textbooks, that support the five general focus areas listed above.
- Funds should go toward projects where students can learn specific STEM topics and have the chance to build and create things that they would otherwise not have the chance to do with the materials the county and school provide.

Ready to apply? Follow these instructions....

**Instructions to use grant portal. If you already have an account start at step 5.**

1. Go to <https://www.finditfunditflorida.com/pinellas>
2. If you already have an account, please start at step 5 to log in and begin.
3. Click on the “Teacher Registration” link on the top, right side of the page.
4. Fill in the information about yourself. You must use pcsb.org email address.
5. Once an account is created, you click on log in on the top right corner.
6. After you’ve logged in, click on the “add a grant request”
7. Fill in the application and submit – If you are applying for the relevant Jabil grant, remember to name the project “Jabil”- whatever else you want to call it”
8. Once you submit the application, your principal will receive an email to approve it.
9. Once your principal approves, we will share your grant with judges at Jabil for funding consideration. In the event you are not selected for funding, your grant will remain on the site for outside donors to consider supporting. We will remove the “Jabil” from the title.
10. Don’t delay applying, this opportunity will close once the funding has been exhausted!
