We have grant funds available for the following categories: STEM, Financial Literacy, Arts Education, and all other subject areas.

It's important to select the appropriate subject category in the grant application to be considered for specific funders.

In the grant application, indicate how you will use this grant to enhance your classroom. The funding may be used to support classroom materials, technology, student needs or engagement. The funding may not be used for food, parties, transportation, field trips, or for a substitute.

Deadline to submit your request is October 30, 2022 at midnight.

Instructions for the site are below.

1. Go to <https://www.finditfunditflorida.com/pinellas>
2. If you already have an account, please start at step 5 to log in and begin.
3. Click on the "Teacher Registration" link on the top, right side of the page.
4. Fill in the information about yourself. You must use pcsb.org email address.
5. Once your account is created, you click on log in on the top right corner.
6. After you've logged in, click on the "add a grant request"
7. Fill in the application and submit – If you are applying for a specific subject area, remember to include it in your project title. For example – **"STEM – Robot Reboot"**
8. Once you submit your application, your principal will receive an email to approve.
9. Once approved by your principal, your proposal will be posted on our website for potential funders.
10. The grant funder will review the applications that come in and you will be notified by the Pinellas Education Foundation if you have been selected to receive funding.
