The Pinellas Education Foundation is pleased to offer classroom grant opportunities for the 2023-2024 school year. This opportunity is open to any Pinellas County Schools teacher.

We have grant funds available for STEM, Financial Literacy, Arts Education, and all other subject areas. The funding may be used for classroom materials, technology, student need or engagement. It cannot be used for food, parties, transportation, field trips or a substitute. All you have to do is complete a grant application indicating how the grant will enhance your classroom.

How to apply

1. Visit: fundaclassroom.org
2. If you already have an account, begin at step 5 to log in.
3. Click "Teacher Registration" on the top, right side of the page.
4. Fill in the required information. You **must use pcsb.org** email address.
5. Once your account is created, click "Log In" on the upper right corner.
6. After logging in, click "add a grant request."
7. Complete the application and submit. If you are applying for a specific subject area, please include it in your project title. For example, "STEM - Robot Reboot."
8. After submission, your principal will receive an email to approve.
9. Grant Funders will review applications and you will be notified by the Pinellas Education Foundation if your grant has been funded.
