4 STEPS TO BECOME A TSIC MENTOR

1. Pinellas Education Foundation's Take Stock in Children (TSIC) program is part of a statewide program supported by the State of Florida's Department of Education. As a statewide program, a new mentor must complete Take Stock in Children's State Mentor Application.
 - Visit [this webpage](#) on Pinellas Education Foundation's website and click on "**Become a Mentor**" to complete the application.
2. After completing your TSIC Mentor Application, you will receive an email with a link to a required TSIC Mentor Training Video. Please follow the two-step instructions in the email to view the video. You must watch this video to continue the process of becoming a mentor. It provides insights on how to assist your mentee with our life-changing scholarship program.
3. The next step is to register as a volunteer with Pinellas County Schools. If you are not currently registered as a volunteer with Pinellas County Schools, you must complete the mandatory registration form at this link [Volunteer Registration Form](#).
 - Be sure to check the box for **Take Stock in Children**. If you wish to volunteer for virtual mentoring, just select any school listed on the form for now and then let us know you will be volunteering virtually instead of in-person mentoring at a school.
4. You will receive an email from Pinellas County Schools once you are approved as a registered volunteer. Pinellas County Schools requires all mentors to complete an in-person or virtual mentor training.
