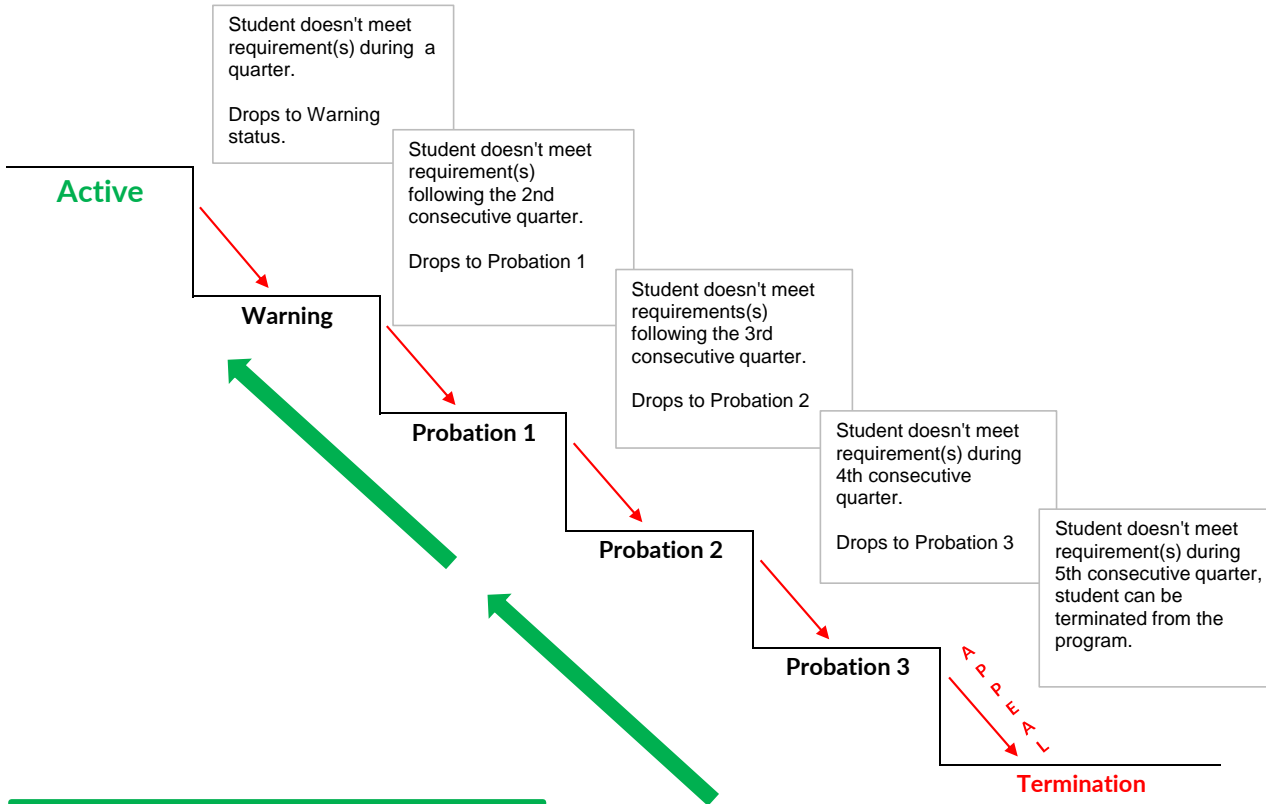


TSIC Pinellas Student Probationary Status Model



If a student meets all requirement(s) during any quarter, they will improve one status level.
 This may continue with consecutive quarters as the student meets all requirements - with a goal to return to Active status.

A student may have the option to complete an **Appeal** prior to termination. Must submit an Appeal by the deadline. Only 1 Appeal allowed.

Determining Factors for a quarterly Probation Status Changes:

- Received a D or F
- Missed more than 5 unexcused absences
- Received an in-school or out-of-school referral
- Illegal drugs or criminal activity – upon notification immediate dismissal.

Students can move up and down a probation level each quarter based on adherence to compliance standards and can move multiple levels based on the number and severity of offenses within a quarter.

Other Discretionary Factors for Probation Status Changes:

- Confirmation of two or more missed coaching sessions, without making any efforts to reschedule the meeting with the coach.
- Confirmation of two or more missed mentor sessions, without attempting to reschedule the session.

If a student receives a request to meet and does not respond, they should take the initiative to arrange for the missed meeting by going through the TSIC school ambassador to schedule a makeup mentor or coaching session.

*Confirmation indicates that the student was present for the school day.
